RING 3: MAIN RING SHOWJUMPING - BS guidelines - A7 Rider/horse combination may not compete in Ring 2 today

Please Note: Horse/Pony competing in Class 10 (Open) or 11 (Maxi Open) may NOT enter Classes 6 or 7 (Novice Classes)

Both sections will run together - dividing for awards if sufficient entries:

Section a) Pony 14.2hh & under - rider Junior 16 years & under on 01.01.2010

Section b) Horse exceeding 14.2hh – rider Senior 17 years & over (or Junior 13 years & over). Senior riders may ride Pony 14.2hh & under providing it does not compete in Junior Pony Classes in 2010

- *CLASS 19) **Riding Horse exceeding 14.2hh - rider any age**
- *CLASS 20a) **Small Breed Mountain & Moorland - rider any age** (including Lead-rein)
- *CLASS 20b) **Large Breed Mountain & Moorland - rider any age** (If insufficient Entries Classes 20a & 20b will combine)
- *CLASS 21) **Cob (Show, Traditional or Cob type) - rider any age**
- *CLASS 22) **Coloured, Spotted, Roan, Dun or Palomino Horse or Pony - rider any age**
