Class SJ7 Horse & Hound Relay 2'0"

Horse And rider to jump first half of course, then return to the start, to dismount and finish the course with a dog on a lead. This will be against the clock with 5 seconds added for a fence down.

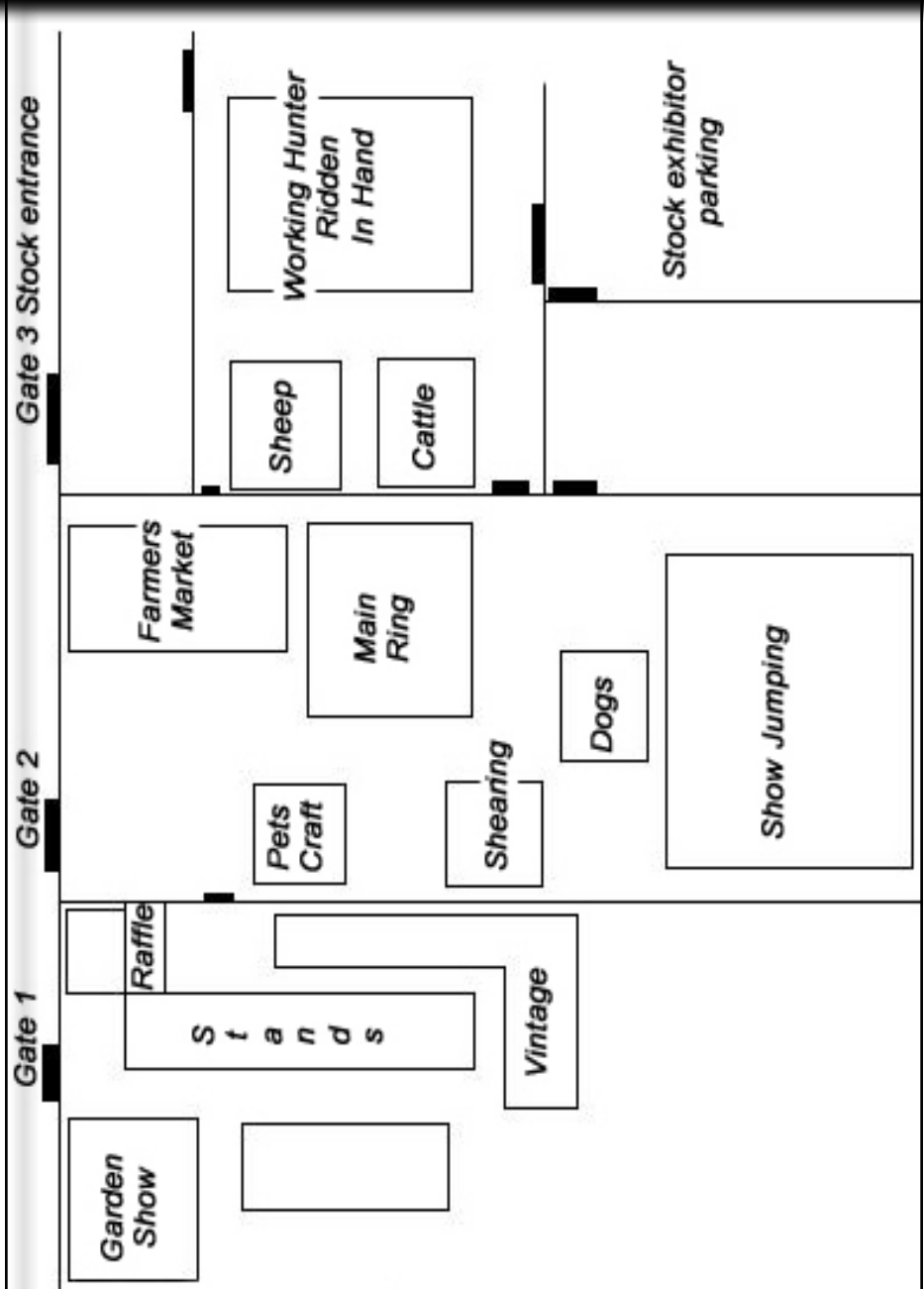

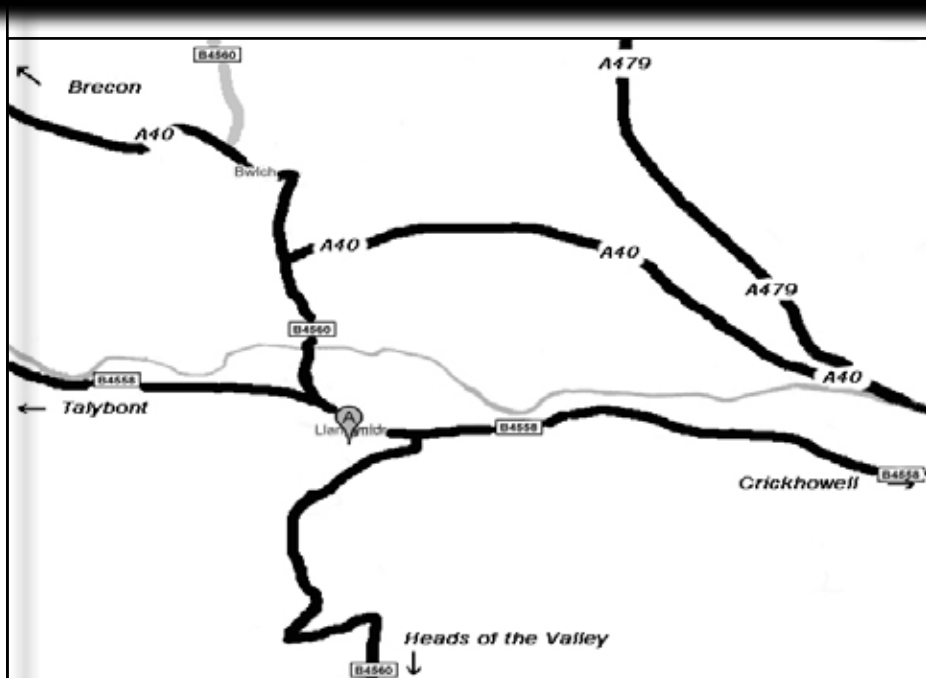
RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

7. Entry fees are not refundable.
