In light of the new restrictions, in order for us to hold this event it needs to be COVID-19 SECURE, please follow these guidelines:

DO NOT attend if you are or any of your household are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms

In order to support the NHS Test and Trace programme, and as a legal requirement, please include the name and contact number of the helper attending with you.

You will be asked to park in a specific area 5m apart from other vehicles

You will be given a warm-up time as well as your test time and these need to be adhered to.

If you are entering more than one class then we ask you to remain with your vehicle until your next set of times

Maintain Social Distancing at all times

Please bring your own water for your horse
