#### BSPS classes rules as per 2023 Rule Book.

Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jump) & the jumping phase in all BSPS organized and Affiliated events Rule 164a.

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS 015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green. Velvet covers are encouraged. The B.S.P.S. encourages members to have their hats tagged through the B.S.P.S. scheme or via the Pony Club Scheme. **Hat Tagging in B.S.P.S. classes is compulsory.** (BSPS is accepting British Eventing, British Riding Club and Pony Club tags).

- Class 3 BSPS Working Hunter Pony. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, and exceeding 133cm(13hh) but not exceeding 143cm(14hh). Suitable to be ridden by rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- **Class 6 BSPS Nursery Stakes.** Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cm (13hh) Suitable to be ridden by rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Class 7 BSPS Cradle Stakes. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cm(12hh) Suitable to be ridden by rider not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- <u>MINI CHAMPIONSHIP</u> 1st & 2nd in Classes 6 & 7 to compete. 1st prizewinners in classes 6 & 7 qualify for BSPS 'Binks Family Mini WHP Champion of Champions.
- Class 8 Novice Mixed Height Working Hunter Pony. WH Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158 cm (15hh). Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride, and jump in their correct height section.

- Class 16 **BSPS Best Show Pony.** Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cm (13.2hh) and not exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). Suitable to be ridden by rider not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

The SSADL head office will notify all champions of the entry procedure, Entry is done via RIHS direct.

**Important:** A competitor may compete in both the In Hand and Ridden qualifiers. However, once a competitor has qualified in the In Hand section, they can still compete in Ridden section BUT are NOT allowed to ENTER in the Ridden Championship and vice vera. Important: Should a competitor win an In Hand class and not wish to go into the In -Hand Championship, then said competitor MUST declare this to the judge and steward. Should this situation arise then the 2nd and 3rd places will go into the In Hand Championship. Once a competitor has qualified for the Grand Final, they may continue to compete in any other show qualifiers, BUT they will NOT be eligible to enter the Championship Qualifier.

**Please Note:** Marks will NOT be used in this qualifier. There will be no pull after the initial go round. No Spurs with exception to Adult Side Saddle riders, No Galloping/Canter Extensions, No Wearing of Face/Body Jewellery, with the exception to the therapeutic earring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted SSADL Classes For In Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. Ridden - First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein ponies will not be stripped, for the strip section, the rider will stay mounted. STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. The same Rider/Handler/Pony/Horse combination must stay the same from First Round Qualifier to Grand Final, unless under special circumstances, on such an occasion the directors may deem it fit to alter said rule.


