RULES

Access to site available from 8:30am.

Please use the warmup rings provided.

Pre-Entries are encouraged, additional classes may be paid for in cash on the day, provided they are not full. All Show jumping classes to be run & judged in accordance with BRC Competition Rules 2024. It is the competitor's responsibility to familiarise themselves with the BRC Rules. These can be downloaded from the BRC website, britishridingclubs.org.uk.

LORRY & VEHICLE PARKING:

All Competitors & others must adhere to instructions from the Parking

Stewards when given. Lorries and Trailers must park with consideration for others and should be at least 5m apart. Horses or ponies tied to a vehicle/trailer must not be left unattended or left in trailers that have been detached from towing vehicles. No skipping out of lorries.

1. All riders must wear suitable footwear and dress. It is compulsory for all riders to wear protective headwear to at least the minimum standard as required in the current BRC Handbook (Rule G22.2). Harnesses must always be correctly adjusted and fastened. Suitable back protectors are recommended for use during jumping activities. Misuse of whips or spurs will be penalised by the judges Spurs are NOT permitted on those under the age of 16 years old.
2. Riders and spectators at all events should always behave appropriately. No riders or spectators shall behave in an offensive, abusive or unpleasant manner to any person. Anyone doing so will be asked to leave the site by the Event Organiser.
3. Horses and Ponies must be at least 4 years of age to attend a WVRC organised ridden event.
4. Stallions are allowed at this event excluding the Novelty Classes and Young Handler Class. They must be bitted and competently handled/ridden by someone who is 18 years or over. If they misbehave, they may be asked to leave the event. Stallion discs should be worn on both sides of the bridle or Stallion Ribbon in the Tail Displayed.
5. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.
6. All attending must have regard and consideration for other property and ensure that all rubbish is deposited in bins provided or removed from the area to a suitable place or taken back home for disposal.
7. Photographs may be taken for use on our website/Facebook. If you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the secretary.

Organisers

8. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel /alter the event/ class in any way and cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule.

In the event of show abandonment, where possible the show will be looked to be rescheduled, if this is not possible one third of the entry fee will be retained to cover costs.

In the case of a competitor no longer able to attend the competition, a refund will not be available if it is less than 7 days before the show.

9. The Judges' decision is final.

10. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.

Health, Safety & Welfare

11. The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all official stewards.
12. If attending the Show on your own, you MUST leave an emergency contact name and telephone number with the Show Organiser when you arrive.
13. Children under 18 must be under adult supervision at all times.
14. Any competitor who has had a fall in a warm-up area, competition arena or anywhere on site must see the paramedic before remounting to start the competition/phase and follow their instructions.
15. Neither WVRC, nor any agent, employee, or representative of WVRC, nor the landowner or his/her tenants will hold themselves responsible for any accident to persons, property and/or horses. By entering in this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding / handling and competing.
16. Non-members are not covered by the BRC insurance policy. It is mandatory for anyone attending this event to have third party liability insurance.
